Information ex art. 13 Law by decree. 196/2003 (Protection of personal data)

Dear Sir/Madam,

we wish to inform you that Italian legislative decree no. 196 of 30th June 2003 (the data protection act) is to protect the personal data of persons and other entities. In accordance with the above act, the data will be used in a correct, lawful and transparent manner to protect your privacy and rights. Therefore, pursuant to article 13 of Italian legislative decree no. 196-2003, we provide you with the following information:

1. Purposes of the data processing.

The treatment is intended only for the satisfaction of information requests we have received through this site.

2. Mode of the data processing.

The treatment is performed by means of transactions or series of transactions listed in Art. 4 paragraph 1 let. A): collection, recording, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

- a. The operations can be performed with or without the aid of electronic data management systems.
- b. The treatment is done by the owner and / or persons in charge of the treatment.

3. Providing data.

The provision of common personal data and sensitive records is necessary for the purposes of conducting the activities referred to in paragraph 1.

4. Refusal to provide data.

Any refusal by the interested party to give personal information in the case referred to in paragraph 3 makes it impossible to perform the activities referred to in paragraph 1.

5. Data communication.

Personal data may be disclosed to those responsible for treatment and may be disclosed for the purposes referred to in paragraph 1 to external partners (companies specializing in the area of customer service, sorting and mailing address) and all those persons to whom disclosure is necessary for the proper fulfillment of the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1.

6. Dissemination of data.

The personal data are not subject to disclosure (Article 4 let. TU m).

7. Transfer of data abroad.

Personal data may be transferred to true EU countries and to countries outside the European Union for the purposes set out in Part 1.

8. Rights of the person concerned.

We also remember you that, in any moment you could exercise Your rights with respect to the owner of the treatment, according to the art. 7 of the Law by decree 196/2003, that, (for your convenience here following we reproduce it entirely), Law by decree n. 196/2003, Art. 7 – Right to access to personal data and other rights:

- a. The party concerned has the right to obtain confirmation whether of the existence of personal data referred to him/her, even if these are still not registered, and their communication in an intelligible way.
- b. The party concerned has the right to obtain the following indications:
 - i. origin of the personal data;
 - ii. purposes and modalities of the treatment;
 - iii. logic applied in case of treatment effected with the help of electronic tools;
 - iv. personal data of the owner, of the responsible and of the nominated representative according to the art.5, paragraph 2;
 - v. parties or categories of parties to whom personal data can be communicated or get knowledge as representative nominated on the State territory, as responsible or charged.
- c. The party concerned has the right to obtain:
 - i. the update, the correction, on the other hand, when he/her is interested, the data integration;
 - ii. the cancellation, the transformation in an anonymous way or the block of the data treated in violation of the law, including the data for which the conservation is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which they have been collected and subsequently treated.

- iii. attestation that the operations mentioned at the letters (a) and (b) have been carried acquaintance, also with regards to his contain, to people to whom data have been communicated or diffused, except in the case when this accomplish becomes impossible or involve an investment of resources clearly disproportionate with respect to the right guaranteed.
- iv. The party concerned has the right to oppose, totally or partially:
 - 1. for lawful reasons lied to the treatment of the personal data concerned to him/her, still pertinent to the purposes of the collection.
 - 2. to the treatment of personal data concerned to him/her with the purpose to dispatch advertising material or direct sale or to perform marketing survays or commercial communication.
